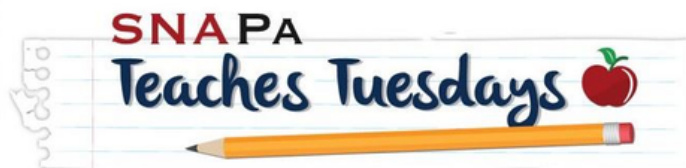


# MONDAY MORNING
