The USDA, as part of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022, (Public Law 117-103), has designated \$30 million to State agencies to competitively award equipment assistance grants to eligible School Food Authorities (SFA) participating in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP).

The Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE), Division of Food and Nutrition (DFN) is receiving \$1,047,427 to distribute to schools through a competitive grant process. The 2022 Food Service Equipment Assistance Grant (FSEG) Application was previously accessible in a paper application format. PDE has transitioned to a web-based eGrants application. Mailed, emailed, or scanned copies will no longer be accepted.

PDE will be hosting a Food Service Equipment Assistance Grant Webinar for interested SFAs on August 31, 2022 from 9:30 to 10:30.

The application is set to open "live", around September 1, 2022. The 2022 Food Service Equipment Assistance Grant application, FAQ List, the USDA memo and other related information are available to view prior to entry in eGrants on PEARS Download Forms, SNP - Grants, Contests, and Other Opportunities section. It is essential that the school reads through all the information carefully and submit the application by **October 14, 2022**.
