A Note from PDE

The Professional Standards for School Nutrition Personnel final rule gives state agencies the discretion to assess compliance with the training requirements over a period of two school years. PDE has chosen to allow this flexibility. School Nutrition Program sponsors in Pennsylvania may carryover training hours to an immediately previous or subsequent school year, provided that some training hours are completed each school year.




