
WINSTON EQUIPMENT GRANT

The FY 2019 Farm to School Grant Program Request for Applications (RFA) is now open to applicants. Due to additional funding made available to the Farm to School Grant Program through the FY 2018 Omnibus Bill, the Office of Community Food Systems seeks to award approximately \$7.5M in FY 2019 funding. The RFA closes December 4, 2018, 11:59pm ET. Late applications will not be accepted. We anticipate releasing award decisions in late spring or early summer of 2019.
